HISTORICAL SKETCH

St. Antony's Covent Higher Secondary School is situated near Mahatma Gandhi Road, Sonkatch - hundred feet away from the main road. This noble foundation of imparting knowledge is established by the Society of the Sisters of Our Lady of the Garden. The school has a favourable atmosphere for learning as it is located in a serene and peaceful vicinity of Sonkatch. The concentrative efforts and ideals have been instrumental in nurturing and developing the school from the very beginning of its Foundation. It stands for social justice, love, concern for the poor and the educational development of the society. We aim to preserve and enhance the highest standard of excellence by giving value based education and to prepare generations for the education coupled with strict discipline for the integrated growth of each student.

The seed of the tree of St. Antony's Covent Higher Secondary School in 1984 with 13 students and the classes were conducted in the convent. In the early phase of the school education was implemented through Hindi Medium. On 3rd July 1996 English Medium was also started as the School grew up with its strength. In the academic year 2012, Higher Secondary classes were introduced with the faculties of Mathematics, Science and Commerce. New block was constructed for the better functioning of the Higher Secondary Section. Today it has grown into a full fledged co-educational Higher Secondary School affiliated to the CBSE New Delhi.

The School is opened to all the students irrespective of caste and creed. Integral education is the core of the school curriculum. The school creates conducive ambiance for the holistic development of the students.

ABOUT THE INSTITUTION

St. Antony's Convent Hr. Sec. School (affiliated to CBSE) is a co-educational institution. The school is presently from Nursery to class XII. The school is managed by The Society of the Sisters of Our Lady of the Garden and is committed to the mission of education for building a proficient, integral and caring society.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

The aim of the institution is to impart quality education and prepare the young ones to seek opportunities for life in the fast advancing technological society.

Our main objectives are

FACILITIES

- COMPUTER LAB** : The school has a computer lab with 30 computers. Students are taught computers from class 1 onwards.
- LIBRARY** : To help students acquire additional knowledge and develop in them a taste of reading, the school has a vast library containing a large collection of academic and informative books.
- LABORATORIES** : The school has spacious, furnished and well equipped laboratories for Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Mathematics.
- SMART CLASSES** : Teachers make use of this facility to teach students with the aid of multimedia educational capsules and projection.
- GROUNDS** : The school has wide open and well developed grounds for football, Basketball, Athletics, Kho-Kho and Volleyball.
The school also provides filtered drinking water for the students. First aid facility is available for minor injuries and ailments.
- VALUE EDUCATION CLASSES** : Students are provided with value based education and leadership training.
- KARATE, MUSIC, DANCE, YOGA** etc for the overall development of the students.
- CARRIER COUNSELLING** : A one to one interaction between students and experts is also done to facilitate clearing students queries and doubts.



ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Admission is open to both boys and girls based on merit. Application for admission shall be on the prescribed form attached with the prospectus.

Policies:

- A child who completes 3 years by July 1st is eligible for seeking admission in Nursery. A child who completes 3 and half years by July 1st is eligible for seeking admission in K.G.- I
- The original Birth certificate from the Municipality / Panchayat and a photocopy of it should be produced. No other type of Birth certificate shall be accepted.
- Selection is baseline to, the student's bio-data, parental co-operation, general fitness and aptitude for learning.

Withdrawals :

An application has to be made to the principal at least one month prior to the date of leaving.

Note: Fees once paid will not be refunded.

Admission to Class XI:

- Admission is open to the availability of seats and student's eligibility and it is primarily reserved for our students.
- The applicant has to register for the examination.
- The applicants shall be examined in English, Mathematics, Science and General Knowledge in the admission test.
- The result will be published within five days.
- Selected students should come along with their parents for the admission.
- Once the result of the entrance examination is announced the admission formalities should be completed within five days.

The school offers the following subjects:

- English
- Mathematics
- Physics
- Accountancy
- Economics
- Hindi-B
- Biology
- Chemistry
- Business Studies

Note: They will have computer course with the above prescribed syllabus.

As the seats are limited all students can not be admitted in the above groups.

Therefore the criteria for selection and admission are as follows.

- The school prepares a merit list, taking the average of the internal assessment and the board result of class X.
- Students may get the group of their choice, according to their performance and availability of seats.
- Apart from the academic performance, the conduct of a student should be good in the school report.

FEES STRUCTURE :

- The fee paid, will not be refunded after the completion of admission formalities.
- Advance payment is welcomed. Discount in fees will be granted for those who pay total fee at the beginning of the academic year
- The fee is to be paid in 4 installments which are as follows:
 - 1st Install. - July. - 1st to 15th
 - 2nd Install. - Oct. - 1st to 15th
 - 3rd Install. - Dec. - 1st to 15th
 - 4th Install. - Feb. - 1st to 15th
- Time for the fee payment is 10.00 am to 2.00 pm
- All fees must be fully cleared before a student is admitted for semester examinations.
